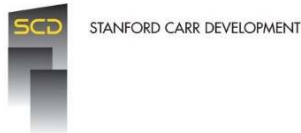

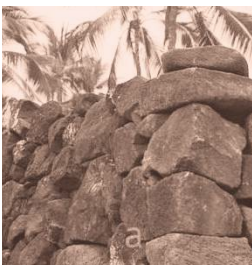

FAQ'S

Is my donation tax-deductible?

AIA Honolulu is a 501(c)(6) business league under IRS requirements. Therefore, donations are not tax deductible as charitable donations, but may qualify as a business expense. Please consult your tax advisor for more information.

Can I make an in-kind or non-monetary donation to a specific committee or program?

Yes, committees can accept in-kind donations such as food and beverage, event-specific resources, etc. These types of donations do not normally qualify for AIA Honolulu Annual Sponsorship. Please contact staff for more information.

How long is my sponsorship good for?

Sponsorship is good for the calendar year from January 1 to December 31, 2023, rather than 12 months from date of commitment. Therefore, the earlier in the year you commit as a sponsor, the greater the benefit.

Does my recognition only apply to the programs/initiatives I have selected?

By sponsoring any single program or initiative, your company automatically is made an Annual Sponsor of AIA Honolulu. Annual Sponsors enjoy year-round benefits and recognition, in addition to program-specific recognition.

How do I get the most out of sponsoring AIA Honolulu?

Be sure to commit as early as possible to receive sponsorship benefits starting January 1, 2023. AIA Honolulu encourages sponsors to stay in touch with the committees and programs they choose to support, and welcomes any feedback to ensure that sponsorship value is maintained.
