UPJOHN RESEARCH INITIATIVE CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The AIA Upjohn Research Initiative supports applied research projects that enhance the value of design and professional practice knowledge. The program funds up to six research grants of \$15,000–\$30,000 annually for projects completed within an 18-month period. Upjohn grant recipients' research findings and outcomes are published online by AIA. The call for submission is now open through October 15, 2025. More information can be found [here](#).

The Governance Task Force convened for its sixth meeting in August to advance AIA's governance assessment and prepare for the development of formal recommendations.
